

Harvest Fund Advisors LLC Privacy Policy

Harvest Fund Advisors LLC (“Harvest” or the “Funds”) recognizes how important it is for you to feel confident in the knowledge that your personal financial information is secure. We have earned your trust over the years by safeguarding the personal and financial information that you have entrusted to us.

In the course of doing business with investors, Harvest collects nonpublic personal information about you and our other investors. “Nonpublic personal information” is personally identifiable financial information. For example, it includes the amount of your LLC or account interest, representations about your or your organizations assets and income which you made to us, and your investment and withdrawal history.

Harvest collects this information from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you in subscription documents or Investment Management Agreements; and,
- Information about your transactions done with us and our service providers or others.

What information the Funds disclose and to whom the Funds disclose information.

Harvest only discloses nonpublic personal information that we collect as required and permitted by law. For example, Harvest may disclose nonpublic personal information about you:

- To government entities, in response to subpoenas or to comply with laws or regulations;
- When investors direct the Funds to do so or consent to the disclosure;
- To companies that perform necessary services for the Funds, such as our external auditors, outside counsel, and service providers that process or service Harvest’s transactions (including custodians, broker-dealers, prime brokers, and banks); and,
- To protect against fraud.

We do not share your information for marketing purposes or for any reason other than as noted above.

Information about former investors.

If an investor withdraws from a Harvest fund or a Harvest account, we will adhere to the privacy policies and practices described in this notice.

How we safeguard information.

Within Harvest, access to nonpublic personal information about our investors is limited to our employees and in some cases to third parties (for example, the service providers described above), as permitted by law. We and our service providers maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards to guard nonpublic personal information.
